

TEAR It UP

Tear into this idea! All it takes is some **RIPPED UP** paper to make a collage of an eight-armed octopus!



1. Tear a large circle out of colored paper for your octopus's head and body. (Don't worry if it's not perfectly round.) Glue it onto a large piece of craft paper.



2. Tear eight long, thin paper strips out of tissue or construction paper for your octopus's arms. Glue them around your octopus's body. (If you like, you can tuck the edges of the arms under your octopus's head and body.)

3. Tear a few small circles out of scraps of paper and glue them onto your octopus's body to add a few silly spots.



OH! An Awesome Octopus!

Add a friendly face to your octopus by gluing on more ripped paper to make eyes, cheeks, a smiling mouth and teeth. For a finishing touch, use a marker to draw lots of little circles along your octopus's arms for its suction cups.

A collage made out of paper that has been torn or ripped into different shapes is called a **TORN PAPER COLLAGE**.
