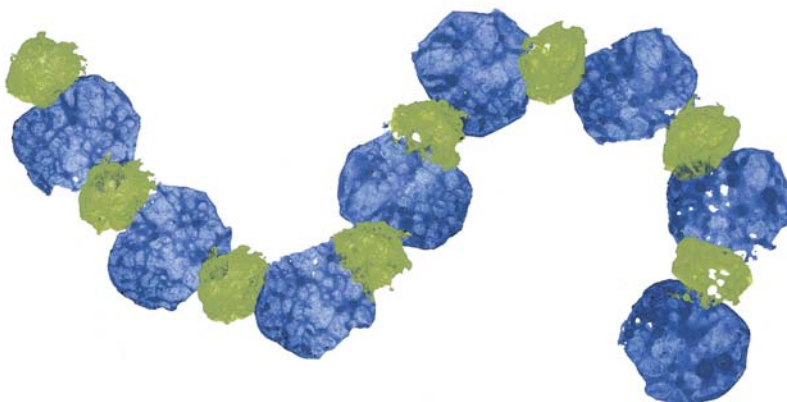
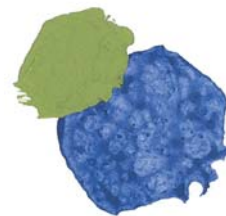


PRESSED-ON Pattern

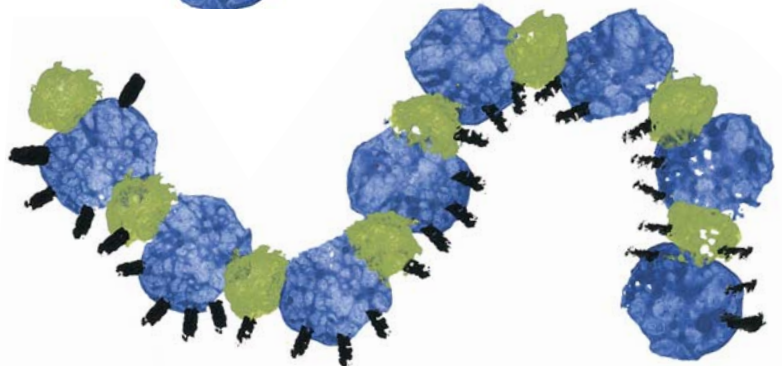
Use painted sponges to make a pattern that looks like a caterpillar
CREEPING and *CRAWLING* across your page!

1. Dab a large sponge into a blob of brightly colored paint. Gently press the sponge onto your paper. Dab a smaller sponge into a blob of a different-colored paint. Gently press the sponge onto your paper, right next to the first print.



2. Repeat Step 1 over and over until you fill the page with a long, curving caterpillar's body. Let the paint dry.

3. Bend the tip of a pipe cleaner to make an "L." Dab the short end of the pipe cleaner into a blob of black paint. Gently press the pipe cleaner along your caterpillar's body to make lots of fuzzy legs. Let dry.



ZOOM! A Crazy Caterpillar!

Use a small paintbrush and paint to give your caterpillar a few colorful stripes and spots, antennae and a face. Dip your baby finger in paint to make fingerprints that look like scurrying feet!

A **PATTERN** is a design that is repeated. By putting a large print next to a small print over and over for the caterpillar's body, you made a pattern.
