

FORMING an IDEA

What can you make out of two egg cartons, two cotton balls and two empty spools of thread? How about a **HUNGRY CROCODILE?**

1. Carefully cut along the fold of an egg carton. Make a crocodile's head with open jaws by taping the two pieces of carton together at one end. (You might need a helper to hold the pieces while you tape.) Paint the head green with a fat brush.



2. Glue two cotton ball eyes near the taped end of the crocodile's jaws. Next glue two spool nostrils near the open end.

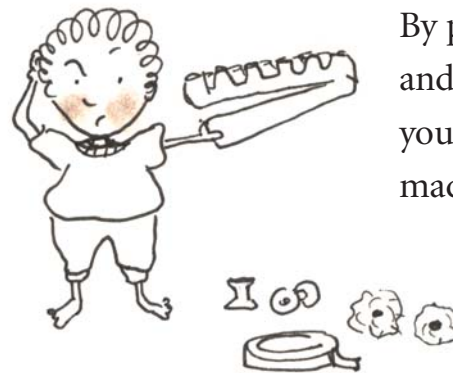
3. Cut some triangle teeth out of construction paper or a sheet of craft foam. Glue them along the inside of your crocodile's jaws.



CHOMP, CHOMP!

A Toothy Crocodile!

Give your crocodile a body by lining up another painted egg carton. Next add four legs and a tail shaped out of modeling clay. Cut and place a red fabric or paper tongue inside the mouth. Glue a small button or bead to the center of each cotton ball eye. Now your croc is complete!



By putting different materials and shapes together to make your crocodile, you have made a **FORM**.
